Guidelines 2025-2026

Buckeye Lake for Tomorrow Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3), of the Internal Revenue Code.

The mission of Buckeye Lake for Tomorrow, Inc. is to facilitate and promote actions that will enhance quality of life through improved water quality for the benefit of recreation, agriculture, wildlife, and other users of the Buckeye Lake Watershed aquatic resources.

Our Vision is:

- to work with stakeholders who are committed to sustaining Buckeye Lake water resources for future generations to enjoy.
- to develop and implement a watershed action plan that results in improved water quality in the Buckeye Lake Watershed over the next ten years.
- to work with communities around Buckeye Lake to ensure a multijurisdictional plan is created to guide development in a lake-sustaining manner.
- to develop a long-term volunteer water quality monitoring program and share results with the community.
- to inform the public about the steps they can take to help improve the water quality of Buckeye Lake and the Buckeye Lake Watershed.

Our Objectives are:

- to promote the reduction of nonpoint pollution from all potential sources that may include agricultural, commercial, residential and recreation.
- to develop and offer youth-adult educational opportunities regarding relevant watershed management topics.
- to foster cooperation between agriculture, commercial residential and recreational interests in order to enable coordinated action toward common goals.
- to assist area decision makers in the development and coordinated adoption of sound watershed management policies.

Scope of the Award:

For 2025-2026 academic school year, Buckeye Lake for Tomorrow will present the Merv Bartholow Memorial Scholarship in the amount of \$1000.

Criteria and eligibility:

1. Applicant must attend Lakewood High School.
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
3. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average (or a "B" average).
4. Applicant must be pursuing a STEM, STEM education, or agricultural related field.
5. Applicant must provide evidence of acceptance and commitment to a 2- or 4-year institution of higher learning.

General Instructions:

1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is Tuesday, **April 1, 2026, 2:30 p.m.** (no exceptions).
2. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., transcript, etc.). Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. If any question does not apply to you in this application, please put N/A in the space.
4. Type and print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered.
5. Scholarship winners will be announced at Lakewood High School Senior Honors Night in May 2026.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
2. Three (3) recommendations from your choice of high school teachers, administrators, or counselors, with significant knowledge of applicant's academics, experience, and involvement. A signature is required for these recommendations. Letters are not required.
3. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing/rank.
4. Completed Essay Question. Responses should be no more than 500 words in a typed, double-spaced, 12-point font document.

Deadline for the application is **April 1, 2026, 2:30 p.m.**
Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
